Definitions and concepts for the chart below:

Functional Purpose: Substance imparts desired function in the finished product component. It must be both intentionally used in the manufacturing and have a purpose in the finished product in order to trigger reporting in quantities >PQL.

Contaminant: Substance serves no desired function in the finished product and appears as an impurity, byproduct, residual intermediate, or degradation product. Report if found at levels >100 ppm AND there is no existing Manufacturing Control Program (MCP) that is intended to "minimize" the presence of substance.
