



SAFETY TIPS FOR ONCE THE TOYS ARE UNWRAPPED...



Discard All Packaging

Remove and discard toy packaging before giving playthings to a baby or small child.



Supervision Required

Create a safe space for your child to play and always supervise playtime. Demonstrate the correct way to safely play with the toys.



Read Instructions

Follow instructions for assembly and use — and save them! Complete product warranties and keep any assembly hardware.



Age Labels

Keep toys for older kids out of reach of younger siblings. Enlist their help in keeping toys out of the hands of little ones.



Battery Safety

When installing or replacing batteries in a toy, carefully re-engage the locking mechanism of the battery compartment. Throw away used batteries right away — never leave batteries out and within a child's reach. If your child swallows a battery, seek medical attention immediately.
